NOTICE OF RACE

1 Rules

- 1.1 The Event will be governed by
 - the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 (the prescriptions of the Hong Kong Sailing Federation will not apply)
 - the current class rules of competing classes
 - the rules of the ISAF Small Catamaran Handicap Rating System (SCHRS) as administered by the HKHC Committee
 - the Notice of Race
 - the Open Catamaran Cup Sailing Instructions.

Succeeding items in this list will take precedence.

- 1.2 All sailors shall wear a personal flotation device whilst afloat.
- 1.3 The Organizing Authority recommends that all sailors carry a sharp knife which is accessible at all times whilst sailing.
- 1.4 Succeeding items in this list will take precedence.

2 Advertising

2.1 Advertising will be in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority.

3 Entry and Eligibility

- 3.1 The Event is open to all beach catamarans with SCHRS rating of 1.035 or less.
- 3.2 There must be 3 or more entries to constitute a class.
- 3.3 To enter, complete the online entry form at <u>https://docs.google.com/forms/d/e/1FAIpQLScILL2eG0yeDx4P9qIYZohH7aIGFK5SHJQoRVV0</u> <u>riPwcv9h3A/formResponse</u> by 28th September 2018. Payment of the entry fee can be made by:

- direct debit from HKHC membership account, or;
- bank transfer to Hang Seng Bank Limited, Causeway Bay Branch, 28 Yee Wo Street, Causeway Bay, Hong Kong for the credit of 'HONG KONG HOBIE CLUB LTD', account number 024-281-075457-001. Please email the transfer receipt to Club Secretary once done, or
- post to The Hong Kong Hobie Club, GPO Box 11697, Hong Kong), a HK Dollar cheque payable to 'The Hong Kong Hobie Club Ltd'.
- 3.4 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organizing authority.
- 3.5 All teams are required to comply with their Class Weight Rules. The organizing authority reserves the right to weigh a team, if it believes it to be under the minimum weight limit.
- 3.6 Helms and crews shall register and weigh in with the organizing authority at the Welcome/Registration Party on Thursday 27th September 2018 between 1900 – 2100 or if prior arrangements with the HKHC Secretary have been made, on Saturday 29th September 2018 at To Tei Wan beach between 0900 - 0945.
- 3.7 Failure to complete all the registration requirements by 0945 hrs on Saturday 29th September 2018 will invalidate the entry.
- 3.8 Crew change requests for crew change must be made in writing on the Request for a Change of Crew form and submitted to the Race Office.
- 3.9 All boats must have adequate insurance to cover racing risks whilst in Hong Kong (not less than HK\$1,000,000 for third party risk). Proof of insurance and coverage must be shown at registration.

4 Entry Fee

- 4.1 The entry fee is HK\$1,200 per boat for entries received and paid by Friday 17th August 2018. For entries received or paid after Friday 17th August 2018, the entry fee will be HK\$1,500.
- 4.2 The entry fee will cover the cost of boat entry and all social events for the helm and crew. Guest tickets for socials will be available from the Club Secretary.

5 Charter Boats

A limited number of high quality Hobie catamarans will be available for charter. Please contact Tong Shing for details (tongshing@bluefin.com.hk) as soon as possible.

6 Programme of Events

The Open Catamaran Cup 2018 will consist of a maximum of 12 geometric races. 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a series. One additional island race will be arranged but the result does not count with the overall scoring of the championship.

7 Venue

- 7.1 The regatta base will be located at the Hong Kong Hobie Club, To Tei Wan Beach, Tai Tam.
- 7.2 The racing area will be within Tai Tam Bay or in the vicinity of west of Beaufort and Po Toi Islands.

8 Weather Conditions

Temperatures are expected to be 22° -- 30° C, with wind speeds from 6 to 20 knots. Water temperature will be about 22° C.

9 Courses to be Sailed

Geometric courses to be sailed will be a mix of windward/leeward and triangular courses.

10 Sailing Instructions

- 10.1 Sailing Instructions will be published on the HKHC's website http://www.hobieclub.org.hk one week before the regatta.
- 10.2 Sailing Instructions will also be available at registration.

11 Penalty System

RRS rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turn Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

12 Scoring System

- 12.1 The low-point scoring system as per RRS Appendix A will be used.
- 12.2 Discards will be as follows:
 - If 4 or less races are completed there will be no discard.
 - If 5 or more races are completed there will be 1 discard.
 - If 10 or more races are completed there will be 2 discards.

13 Protest Committee

A Protest Committee will be appointed.

14 Radio and Mobile Phone Communications

A boat shall neither make nor receive radio or mobile phone communications.

15 Prizes

- 15.1 Prizes will be awarded to the first boat.
- 15.2 Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.

16 Disclaimer

- 16.1 Competitors participate in the Open Catamaran Cup 2018 entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority, the event sponsors and their representatives, officers, members and volunteers will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 16.2 The term "Skipper" shall mean the person, whether or not the owner of the boat, who is designated on the entry form as the "helm". The skipper shall be in charge of the boat during the Event and is responsible for the boat, its handling and safety, conduct of the crew before, during and after each race and compliance with the Sailing Instructions.
